

Rector's Order No. 2/2026 (V.19.)

on the rules for applications for short-term student mobility announced under the Pannonia Scholarship Programme, deviating from those set out in the Pannonia Regulations of the Moholy-Nagy University of Art and Design

The Pannonia Scholarship Programme is a higher education scholarship scheme established by the Ministry of Culture and Innovation with the aim of implementing an internationalisation programme among universities that have undergone a model change. The Rector of the Moholy-Nagy University of Art and Design (hereinafter as: the University/MOME), in this order, and taking into account the provisions of the Implementation Guide¹ (hereinafter as: the Guide) published by the Tempus Public Foundation and entering into force on 22 January 2026, hereby establishes transitional provisions applicable with respect to the Pannonia Regulations (hereinafter as: the Regulations) of the Moholy-Nagy University of Art and Design.

Purpose of the order
Section 1

- (1) The purpose of this order is to set out the transitional provisions applicable to the conditions for the submission of applications for student grants set out in the Regulations.
- (2) The revision of the Regulations is currently underway to ensure coherence with the Implementing Guide, but the University intends to regulate the conditions for applications for short-term student mobility in line with the Implementing Guide during this transitional period, and the rules applicable during this transitional period are therefore set out in this order.

Scope of the order
Section 2

- (1) The personal scope of this order applies to students pursuing a bachelor's, master's or doctoral programmes at the University.
- (2) The material scope of this order covers short-term student mobility for study and research purposes within the framework of the Pannonia Scholarship Programme.

Transitional rules for applying for short-term student mobility
Section 3

- (1) In the case of short-term student mobility for study and research purposes, the provisions of paragraphs (2) - (3) of this Section shall apply instead of paragraphs (3) - (4) of Section 9 of the Regulations.
- (2) For short-term study-related student mobility at the University,
 - (a) students enrolled in bachelor's or single-cycle programmes shall be eligible to apply after completing one closed semester; and
 - (b) students enrolled in master's or doctoral programmes shall be eligible to apply from the first semester of their studies.
- (3) For short-term research-related student mobility at the University,

- (a) students enrolled in bachelor's programmes shall be eligible to apply at the end of their studies, in connection with their thesis course(s);
- (b) students enrolled in single-cycle programmes shall be eligible to apply after completing a minimum of seven closed semesters; and
- (c) students enrolled in master's or doctoral programmes shall be eligible to apply from the first semester of their studies.

Closing provisions
Section 4

- (1) This order shall enter into force on the day it is signed.
- (2) This order shall cease to have effect upon its revocation.
