

Rector's Order No. 3/2026 (V.22.)

ON THE MATERIALS GRANT PROVIDED FOR THE DIPLOMA PROJECT

The Rector of the Moholy-Nagy University of Art and Design Budapest (hereinafter as: University or MOME), acting within the duties and powers set out in point a) of paragraph (1) of Section 11 of the Organisational and Operational Rules (hereinafter as: SZMR), which constitutes Volume I of the Organisational By-laws of MOME, and in Section 20 of the MOME Payment and Benefit Policy (hereinafter as: TJSZ), hereby issues the following provisions concerning the materials grant (financial assistance for purchasing materials) provided for the diploma project:

The aim of the grant programme

Section 1

- (1) The purpose of the materials grant (hereinafter as: Grant) provided for the diploma project within the framework of the present Order is to support students enrolled in the University's bachelor's or master's degree programmes who receive state scholarships, who are in the last active semester of their studies, to strengthen their professional attitude and to help them prepare their diploma project in the form of a one-off non-refundable grant.
- (2) The main aim of the Grant is to provide a one-off, non-refundable grant to assist in the preparation of the diploma project.

Scope of the order and persons eligible for the Grant

Section 2

- (1) The personal scope of this order shall apply to students enrolled in the University's bachelor's or master's degree programmes who receive state scholarships, who are in the last active semester of their studies (hereinafter collectively as: Students) who have registered for a final examination in the spring semester of the current academic year.
- (2) Students who have registered for the final examination period but withdraw their registration before the start of the final examination period are not covered by this order.
- (3) Students who have already received a Grant during the period of their studies in the programme in question are also excluded from the scope of this order.
- (4) Notwithstanding Section 20(4) of the TJSZ, a student who has completed less than 30 credits in the last active semester of study prior to the date of his/her application for the final examination period shall also be eligible for the Grant.

Amount and payment of the Grant

Section 3

- (1) The amount of the Grant for the academic year 2025/2026 for students enrolled in a bachelor's degree programme shall be determined as follows:
 - a) For students studying in the Art and Design Theory bachelor's degree programme, the gross amount of the Grant is HUF 10,000 (in words: ten thousand Hungarian forints, gross);
 - b) For students studying in any of the design bachelor's degree programmes not mentioned in point a), the gross amount of the Grant is HUF 20,000 (in words: twenty thousand Hungarian forints, gross).
- (2) The amount of the Grant for the academic year 2025/2026 for students enrolled in a master's degree programme shall be determined as follows:
 - a) For students studying in the Design Theory, the Art and Design Management and in the Teacher training master's degree programmes the gross amount of the Grant is HUF 15,000 (in words: fifteen thousand Hungarian forints, gross);
 - b) For students studying in any of the design master's degree programmes not mentioned in point a), the gross amount of the Grant is HUF 30,000 (in words: thirty thousand Hungarian forints, gross).
- (3) The Grant will be paid to the Grant recipient student in a lump sum by the University after the student's registration for the final examination period during the semester concerned. The conditions of eligibility shall be checked by the Study and Information Centre.

Closing provisions

Section 4

- (1) This order shall enter into force on the day of its signature and shall remain in force until the end of the final examination period of the academic year 2025/2026.
- (2) The Rector reserves the possibility to extend this order to the academic year 2026/2027.
