Pannónia Scholarship Program – Student Short-Term Study Mobility Scholarship for the 2025/26 Academic Year

Short-Term Student Mobilities (BA, MA, Doctoral Levels):

- Study mobility (2-30 days)

For example, participation in conferences, summer schools, or intensive courses.

Short-term study student mobility refers to student mobility directed to specific target countries, based on an inter-institutional agreement and aiming for credit transfer, with a duration of at least 2 days and at most 30 days.

Short-term study mobility may also include participation in conferences, provided the student's **active participation** to the academic content or organization of the conference, i.e., the student presents a lecture or leads a workshop during the conference. Only attending as a participant is not supported. The requirements for conference participation and its acceptance must be documented in the mobility agreement, referencing the study plans or curriculum.

Participation in the general mobility program requires **two completed academic semesters**.

Application deadline: ongoing, depending on the availability of financial resources.

Target Countries and Country Groups

Application Process

Submission of a **personalized invitation letter** issued by the host institution, which includes the **exact dates, the purpose of the visit, and confirmation of active participation**.

The completed **application form** and **Learning Agreement** must be filled out electronically and submitted via email to the Mobility Office at mobility@mome.hu.

On the application form, it is essential to include the approval of the Program Coordinator for the period of absence, confirmed by their signature. Additionally, the number of optional credits to be earned abroad should be discussed and agreed upon.

The applicant is responsible for ensuring they have valid **health, accident, and liability insurance** for the duration of their stay abroad. Possession of a valid European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) is mandatory, and supplementary insurance is also strongly recommended. A copy of the EHIC must be submitted in JPG or PDF format

The documents must be sent to mobility@mome.hu **at least 4 weeks before the planned departure** in order to ensure that the evaluation, preparation, and signing of the agreement by both parties can be completed before the start of the mobility.
