

Your TAJ card allows you to register with and visit a local, district GP.

Find your GP online

Doctors' offices are usually listed online, together with visiting hours. If you want to find your area GP, go to the website of your local municipality. Regarding general practices, each municipality is artificially divided into "areas". To find your local GP, you should **determine which area you belong to within your district**. The area will depend on your exact address (street name and number as well), and areas are numbered. Once you know the area number, you can look up the GP in charge of that area.

(alternatively, you can also call them, but either emailing or calling is necessary!)

The email should include:

Your full name, that you are a **MOME student**, your **TAJ number** and whether you have been there before or not. **When you visit them for the first time, they will need time also for the administration to get you registered in their system.**

They always give you an appointment through email, mostly **for the same day**. If you describe your symptoms in the email and your sickness is less severe, they may be able just upload the prescription for you in the 'cloud' and you can straight go to the pharmacy.

Finally, they pointed out that the last hour of their opening times is usually dedicated to back-office administration therefore they are asking you to treat the above schedule accordingly.
