The purpose of a portfolio is to present your professional journey and relevant previous works. As such, it may contain works or projects closely or loosely related to your selected programme.</p> <p><b>To be submitted along with the portfolio:</b> Brief description of the master project (roughly 2,000-3,000 characters, in A4 format) Identify the issue or area of interest that you would like to explore. Do you have relevant previous experience in a similar field? Describe one or more Hungarian or international examples in a similar field that you find motivating. How do you picture the related research, assessment, and analysis you are expected to do during your Master's programme? The submission is only used to gauge your knowledge, and you are free to choose a different area when completing your Master's.</p>	<p>The printed version of the portfolio does not need to be presented at the interview.</p> <p>The maximum size of the material must not exceed 25 MB. Accepted file format: pdf</p>
