

DR. PETRA ACZÉL is a full professor of communication and rhetoric at Moholy-Nagy University of Arts and Design (MOME), Budapest as well as the member of the MOME Doctoral School. She is the leader of the Future Potentials subproject at FPO, member of the National Research Excellence Council, chief researcher at the National Media and Infocommunications Authority, member of the Communication and Media Committee of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences (HAS) and presides the Montágh Board of the Media Services and Support Trust Fund.



Born in Budapest, she studied at Eötvös Loránd University where she

earned the PhD degree. She gave her habilitation lecture in 2011 and was appointed full professor in 2016. Her research interests are focused on rhetorical theory, visual and sensual rhetoric, media rhetoric and more recently, future potentials and future skills. She has published 8 books and more than 200 academic papers.
